# Christmas Flowers and Greens QR Code:



#### How to use:

- 1: With your smartphone, open your camera as if you are going to take a picture.
- 2: Point the camera at the QR code and center the box in your camera.
- 3: Hold still and once the camera is able to focus on the code, a link box will appear.
- 4: Click on the link and the flower dedication page will be there.

NOTE: Never trust any QR codes unless you know it's safe and internet connection is required.
