NEW STRUCTURE OF THE PRAYER LIST

As we had mentioned in the eNews previously, we have began the clean-up and removed all names that were requested to be added before June 1. If you would like a name to be re-added, feel free to send it your request.

Why the Clean Up?

We want to be able to focus on the pastoral care and give everyone the prayers they deserve. We had many names on the list that were on there for a number of years and unable to get in touch with people for updates causing a lot of additional work that can be spent focusing on pastoral contacts and visits.

How Long Will A Prayer Request Remain on the List?

All requests will stay on the list for 4 weeks. If a name needs to remain on the list, or they are no longer are in need of prayer, you are welcome to contact us to make the changes.

What if the prayer is needed long term? We ask that you continue to request the prayer at the end of the 4 weeks to re-add them so that we can follow up with them or you and give the pastoral care needed when possible.

How Do I Ask For A Prayer Request or Remove a Name?

What Information Do You Need?

If you submit your request through our webpage, it will ask all the questions we will need, however, if you are contacting a person, they will need the following:

- **Name:** Please provide the full name of the person who needs prayer. If you aren't comfortable with the full name, then provide a last name or first name initial. This is to ensure we don't duplicate a name.
Good Examples: Jane Doe, Jane D. or J. Doe Bad Examples: Jane, Ms. Doe or JD
- **Connection To You:** Are they a family member, a friend?
- **Your Name & Contact Information:** This is so we can reach out to you with any further questions.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation in creating the new structure as this will help get pastoral guidance to those who need it.
